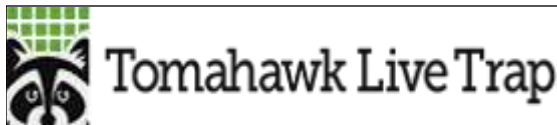
Heading for this years Rendezvous
